INFORMATION & ADVICE WITH SUE



This has been an extremely busy year on the Information and Advice desk at ACEE, receiving hundreds of calls from elderly residents during the height of the first phase of the Coronavirus outbreak and especially from March through to July when we were inundated with requests for help with shopping and getting prescriptions. Luckily our existing volunteers and new ones which had been recruited by our Volunteers Co-ordinator, stepped up to the mark and were a lifeline for people with no local family support, taking essential food and medicines to the doorstep and also providing a friendly face and cheerful words to brighten the lives of very isolated people. Of course our normal work has also continued throughout, with requests for help to obtain benefits and Blue Badges, aids and equipment, hearing aid batteries, support with IT and small handyman jobs, and information about everything from dementia and home adaptations to how to put domiciliary care in place.

With the fantastic advances in the roll-out of vaccines and the widespread testing programme, it seems that we now have this devastating virus 'on the run' and that 2021 will be a much more 'normal' year than the one we are putting behind us. 
